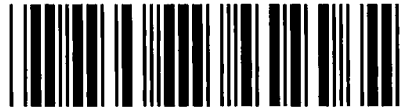

FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT, NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of Harrison Williams and Manvel Terrace Utilities, Inc. filed on July 31, 2020 for approval of a water utility stock transfer under 16 TAC § 24.243.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.


By September 20, 2020, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Leila Guerrero's August 21, 2020 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By October 20, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Under 16 TAC § 22.55, the presiding officer may require a party to provide reasonable notice to affected persons. Commission Staff stated there are only two affected parties in this docket, both of whom are aware of the transaction for which they are seeking approval, and recommended that no further notice be required. The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.
