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COMMISSION STAFF'S UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Unopposed Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On August 10, 2020, Shaneka L. Busby Baker (Ms. Baker) filed a formal complaint against the Veranda Apartments (The Veranda) and Denton Public Facility Corporation (DPFC) (collectively, Respondents) for charges regarding water service.

On December 1, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, requiring Staff to file a supplemental statement of position by January 22, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. On December 1, 2020, Staff filed its First Request for Information to the Veranda apartments (RFI).¹ During correspondence with counsel for the Veranda, Staff was informed that the Veranda requires additional time to respond to Staff's RFI. Staff requires responses to its RFI to draft and file its supplemental statement of position. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that its deadline to submit a supplemental statement of position be extended to February 22, 2021.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ extend the deadline to file a supplemental statement of position to February 22, 2021.
