**ORDER NO. 14**  
**GRANTING AGREED MOTION TO DISMISS,**  
**DISMISSING COMPLAINT, AND CLOSING DOCKET**

This Order addresses the October 1, 2021 agreed motion to dismiss the complaint of Shaneka L. Busby Baker against Veranda Apartments and Denton Public Facility Corporation regarding water service. Attached to the agreed motion to dismiss is a letter, dated September 30, 2021, from Ms. Baker requesting that her complaint be withdrawn.

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.181(g)(1), a party that initiated a proceeding may withdraw the application, without prejudice to refiling, at any time before it has presented a direct case.

The administrative law judge grants the agreed motion to dismiss, dismisses the complaint without prejudice under 16 TAC § 22.181(g)(5), and closes this docket.
