3. Legal name of parent company, if any, and a description of its primary business interests and the name of any companies affiliated with the applicant with which it does any business. Provide the state and date in which the parent and affiliated companies are registered (The Commission requires registration with the Texas secretary of state for all forms of business, except sole proprietorships).
