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### COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL FINAL RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 5, files this Supplemental Final Recommendation. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

### I. BACKGROUND

On August 11, 2020, Johnston Legal Group (Johnston) and Frank Carvalho (Carvalho) (collectively, Petitioners) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release to amend Mountain Peak Special Utility District's (MPSUD) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 10908 in Johnson County, pursuant to Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h) (Petition). Petitioners assert that the tract of land in question is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Johnson County, which is a qualifying county.

On September 9, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, finding the amended application administratively complete and the notice sufficient, and establishing a deadline of October 27, 2020 for Staff to file a recommendation on the final disposition of the application. Staff timely filed its Recommendation on Final Disposition recommending approval of the application.

### II. SUPPLEMENTAL FINAL RECOMMENDATION

Staff's Recommendation on Final Disposition, filed on October 27, 2020 stated that copies of the final map and certificate consented to by the Petitioners were attached to the pleading. However, Staff inadvertently omitted the attachments from the filing. Accordingly,

Staff is filing this Supplemental Final Recommendation to provide the final map and certificate. Staff continues to recommend that the application be approved.

### III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons stated above, Staff provides the attached final map and certificate and recommends approval of the application.




