SWWC Utilities, Inc. d/b/a Hornsby Bend Utility Company, Inc. (HBUC) has reviewed Order No. 4 Finding Application Administratively Incomplete and Providing an Opportunity to Cure, issued September 30, 2020. HBUC requests clarification of the following deadline as issued in Public Utility Commission (Commission) Order No. 4:

By November 4, 2020, Commission Staff must, and SWWC may, provide a supplemental recommendation on the completeness of the application and, if applicable, respond to any briefing by Colorado River Project.

Currently, pursuant to Commission Order No. 3, HBUC has a deadline of October 9, 2020 to submit a response to Colorado River Project, LLC's (CRP) petition. As Commission Order No. 4 has determined CRP's petition is administratively incomplete, HBUC therefore requests that the deadlines identified for HBUC in Order Nos. 3 and 4 be clarified and that HBUC's current deadline of October 9, 2020 to submit a response to CRP's petition be suspended and a new deadline be set at the appropriate time.
