ORDER NO. 8
FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the City of Sweetwater's application to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity number 10228 in Nolan County. On February 10, 2021, Sweetwater filed a first supplement to the application. On May 10, 2021, Sweetwater filed a second supplement to the application following severance of this proceeding and Docket No. 51882.¹

The administrative law judge finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Sweetwater to provide notice of the application and proof that notice was provided, as described in the June 9, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, filed by Commission Staff on the same date. Sweetwater is required to provide notice using the forms included in that filing.


The following procedural schedule applies:

Event	Date
Deadline for Sweetwater to file with the Commission signed affidavits that notice was given, along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	July 26, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a supplemental procedural schedule	August 5, 2021
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
