FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by the City of Sweetwater regarding its application to amend water certificate of convenience and necessity number 10228 in Nolan County. On July 26, 2021, Sweetwater filed: (1) the affidavit of Danielle Lam, attorney for Sweetwater, attesting that individual notice was mailed to all required parties on June 25, 2021; and (2) a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice in the *Sweetwater Reporter*, a newspaper of general circulation in Nolan County, on June 29 and July 6, 2021.

On August 5, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding Sweetwater's notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge finds Sweetwater's notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:
