**ORDER NO. 17**  
**GRANTING EXTENSION AND REVISING DEADLINE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's December 10, 2021 request to extend the time for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. Commission Staff's request was included in its final recommendation on the application. Commission Staff states that because this proceeding includes an intervenor, the parties agree that additional time is required to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's request for extension. By December 22, 2021, the parties must file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law.
