**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,  
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of the City of Sweetwater filed on August 14, 2020, to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10228 and for dual certification with a portion of Bitter Creek Water Supply Corporation's CCN number 11149 in Nolan County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By October 14, 2020, the City of Sweetwater must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Patricia Garcia's September 14, 2020 memorandum. Additionally, the City of Sweetwater must respond to Georgia Pacific, LLC's September 11, 2020 request under 16 TAC § 24.227(i) to have the 234-acre portion of Georgia Pacific's 287-acre tract removed from Sweetwater's application. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information and response, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By November 13, 2020, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate. In its supplemental recommendation, Commission Staff must include comments and a recommendation regarding Georgia Pacific, LLC's September 11, 2020 request, if appropriate.
