**ORDER NO. 7
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Whispering Oaks Water Works and MiBroMa 3 LLC regarding the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Gillespie County. The applicants filed proof of notice on April 28 and 29, 2021, and May 19 and 20, 2021. Commission Staff recommended the notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:



Deadline for intervention	June 18, 2021 ¹
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a final recommendation on approval of the sale	July 19, 2021
Deadline for parties to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation	August 2, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	August 16, 2021
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	September 16, 2021 ²

¹ Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(b), the intervention period shall not be less than 30 days unless good cause is shown. Notice was completed on May 19, 2021, and June 18, 2021 is 30 days later.

² Under 16 TAC § 24.239 (a) and (j), the deadline for Commission action is 120 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. One hundred and twenty days after May 19, 2021, is Thursday, September 16, 2021.
