ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of Trinity Bay Conservation District and Gulf Coast Authority's petition filed on August 20, 2020, for approval of a service area contract, and to amend sewer certificates of convenience and necessity in Chambers County.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and notice sufficient.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline to intervene	October 5, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to petitioners for review and consent	November 5, 2020
Deadline for petitioners to file consent forms with the Commission	November 19, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the petition	December 3, 2020
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	December 10, 2020
