An original and nineteen (19) copies of exceptions and replies to exceptions must be filed with the Commission filing clerk and a copy must be served on all parties of record. **In light of the Commission's Order entered in Docket No. 50664, this requirement is satisfied if pleadings are filed with the Commission through the Interchange on the Commission's website.**<sup>1</sup> The exceptions and replies **MUST** follow the outline of the Proposal for Decision. However, parties may include additional sections at the end. All filings must include both the SOAH docket number and the Commission docket number. Parties should include all grounds, legal and factual, in the exceptions and replies as appropriate; there is no provision for subsequent rounds of pleadings. **LATE FILED MATERIAL MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

Your presence at the open meeting is not required, but you are welcome to attend by calling in to the conference call number, which will be posted on the Commission's website prior to the meeting. A copy of the signed order will be mailed to you shortly after the open meeting.
