ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL AND DISMISSING PETITION

This Order addresses the motion of Crook Rose, Inc. to withdraw its petition for streamlined expedited release without prejudice. The Commission grants Crook Rose's request to withdraw its petition and dismisses the petition without prejudice.

On September 3, 2020, Crook Rose filed a petition to release a tract of land in Smith County from Lindale Rural Water Supply Corporation's service area under certificate of convenience and necessity number 10758. Lindale Rural filed a motion to abate this proceeding on February 22, 2021, which the administrative law judge granted on March 18, 2021.

On January 18, 2022, Crook Rose filed with the Commission a motion to withdraw its petition without prejudice. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.181(g)(3), a request to withdraw an application with or without prejudice after a proposed order has been issued may only be granted upon a finding of good cause by the Commission. Based upon the Commission's consideration of the motion to withdraw and the procedural requirements for withdrawal, the Commission finds that good cause exists to grant Crook Rose's request to withdraw its petition without prejudice. Accordingly, the Commission grants Crook Rose's request to withdraw its petition in this proceeding and dismisses the petition without prejudice under 16 TAC § 22.181(d)(10).
