COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and in response to Order No. 3, files this Recommendation on Final Disposition. Staff recommends that the petition be approved. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On September 22, 2020, LDG001, LLC (LDG001) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Mountain Peak Special Utility District's (Mountain Peak) Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) number 10908 in Johnson County, under Texas Water Code § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Specifically, LDG001 seeks the streamlined expedited release of the portion of its 48-acre tract of land that lies within the boundaries of Mountain Peak's water CCN No. 10908.

On September 29, 2020, Mountain Peak filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding. On October 7, 2020, Order No. 2 was issued, granting the motion to intervene. On October 23, 2020, Order No. 3 was issued, finding the petition administratively complete and establishing a deadline of November 24, 2020 for Staff to file its recommendation on final disposition. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STATUTORY APPROVAL DEADLINE

Under TWC § 13.2541(c), the Commission shall grant the petition for streamlined expedited release not later than the 60th day after the date the landowner files the petition. A

petition is not considered filed until it is deemed administratively complete. LDG001's petition was deemed administratively complete in Order No. 3, issued October 23, 2020. Therefore, the 60-day deadline for administrative approval is December 22, 2020.

III. FINAL RECOMMENDATION

As supported by the attached memorandum from Alicia Maloy, Infrastructure Division, Staff recommends that the petition be approved. Staff recommends that LDG001's petition satisfies the requirements of TWC § 13.2541(b) and 16 TAC § 24.245(h). Specifically, the petition demonstrates that the property which LDG001 seeks streamlined expedited release is located in a qualifying county (Johnson County), is at least 25 acres in size, is not receiving sewer service, and is at least partially located in the Mountain Peak's water-certificated service area. In addition, LDG001 has provided deeds confirming its ownership of the property.

Accordingly, Staff recommends that LDG001's petition for streamlined expedited release be approved. The final water CCN map and certificate are attached to this filing. Staff additionally recommends that the final map and certificate be provided to Mountain Peak and that Mountain Peak file a certified copy of the CCN map and a boundary description of the CCN service area in the Johnson County Clerk's office, as required under TWC § 13.257(r)-(s).

IV. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that LDG001's petition be approved and that an order be issued consistent with the foregoing recommendations.

¹ 16 TAC § 24.8(d) states that applications under subchapter H of chapter 24 are not considered filed until the commission makes a determination that the application is administratively complete, which includes streamlined expedited releases under 16 TAC § 24.245(h).

On September 22, 2020, LDG001, LLC (Petitioner) filed an application for expedited release from Mountain Peak Special Utility District's (Mountain Peak) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10908 in Johnson County, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). The Petitioner asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Johnson County, which is a qualifying county. Mountain Peak requested to intervene.

The Petitioner submitted adequate maps delineating the requested area for expedited release with enough detail to confirm the accurate positioning of its digital data under 16 TAC § 24.245(k). The map and digital data are sufficient for determining the locations of the requested release areas within Mountain Peak's certificated area. Mapping Staff was able to confirm the acreage of the subject property and determined that the requested areas are located within Mountain Peak's water CCN. Furthermore, the Petitioner provided warranty deeds confirming the Petitioner's ownership of the tracts of land within Mountain Peak's certificated area. In addition, the Petitioner submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the property was not receiving water from the CCN holder. The area being requested for expedited release is approximately 48 acres.

In accordance with TWC § 13.2541 and 16 TAC § 24.245(h), the Petitioners have met the Commission's requirements to allow for the release of the requested area from Mountain Peak's CCN No. 10908. Therefore, I recommend approval of the petition. Enclosed is a final map and certificate for Commission approval.

Additionally, I recommend that a final map and certificate be provided to the CCN holder. Pursuant to TWC §§ 13.257 (r)-(s), I further recommend that Mountain Peak file the following information in the Johnson County Clerk's office: (1) a certified copy of the CCN map; (2) a

| certified copy of the amended certificate; and (3) a boundary description of the CCN service area. | | | | | | | |






10908 - Mountain Peak SUD
