**ORDER NO. 8  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING  
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by G&W Water Supply Corporation and the City of Hempstead regarding the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Waller County. The applicants filed proof of notice on May 10, 2021. Commission Staff recommended the notice be found sufficient.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	August 2, 2021
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	September 2, 2021 <sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(b), the intervention period shall not be less than 30 days unless good cause is shown. Notice was mailed on April 12, 2021, and published on April 28, 2021, and May 5, 2021. Therefore, 30 days after May 5, 2021, is June 4, 2021.

<sup>2</sup> Under 16 TAC § 24.239 (a) and (j), the deadline for Commission action is 120 days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. One hundred and twenty days after May 5, 2021 is September 2, 2021.
