COMMISSION STAFF'S UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Unopposed Request for Extension. In support, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On October 1, 2020, Munson Point Property Owner's Association (Munson Point) filed an application for authority to change its water and sewer rates and for a pass through rate change.

On November 16, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, which set a deadline of December 16, 2020 for Staff to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice. Staff was also directed to file clarifications regarding processing. Specifically, whether (1) this application contains more than a single application; (2) severance may be appropriate; and (3) de-docketing as to the requested pass through is appropriate. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff continues to work with the representative for Munson Point, who has indicated Munson Point's intention to file an amended application, along with revised notices for the base rate change and pass-through rate. For this reason, Staff requests that the deadline for its comments on administrative completeness and clarification on the issues noted in Order No. 2 be extended to January 14, 2021. Staff has conferred with Munson Point's authorized representative who indicated that Munson Point is unopposed to the requested extension.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ grant an extension of time for Staff to file comments on administrative completeness and clarification on the three issues raised in Order No. 2.
