**ENTERGY TEXAS, INC.'S NOTICE OF CONFIDENTIAL FILING**

Entergy Texas, Inc. ("ETI") filed an application to update its Generation Cost Recovery Rider related to the Montgomery County Power Station on March 2, 2021. Portions of the Schedule VII-U1 (Taxes Other Than Income Taxes) Workpapers (HSPM) and the Schedule VII-U2 (Taxes Other Than Income Taxes) Workpapers (HSPM) contain commercially sensitive information that is considered Highly Sensitive Protected Material. ETI hereby designates the redacted portions of those workpapers Highly Sensitive Protected Material under the Commission's standard Protective Order. This notice is filed to comply with the requirements of paragraph 4 of the Protective Order relating to the claims of exemption from public disclosure pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act ("TPIA").<sup>1</sup>

The designated material is exempt from public disclosure pursuant to TPIA §§ 552.101, 552.104, and/or 552.110. These workpapers contain certain financial information of ETI. It has not been publicly disclosed and is not intended for public disclosure. If released, it would give a competitive advantage to ETI's competitors, and is therefore protected under TPIA § 552.104. Further, the public disclosure of this information has an unreasonable risk of substantial competitive harm to ETI. As a result, this information is exempt from public disclosure under TPIA § 552.110. In light of the sensitive nature of these documents, they constitute highly sensitive material pursuant to the Commission's standard Protective Order.

The undersigned counsel for ETI has reviewed the information sufficiently to state in good faith that the information is exempt from public disclosure under the TPIA and merits the confidential and highly sensitive protected material designation.
