**ORDER NO. 4  
FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT,  
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of East Crawford Water Supply Corporation and North Bosque Water Supply Corporation's application, filed on October 7, 2020, for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in McClennan County. Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the sufficiency of the application on December 16, 2020.<sup>1</sup>

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before January 15, 2021, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the December 16, 2020 memorandum of Patricia Garcia. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before February 15, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
