#### **APPLICANTS' JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION**

**COMES NOW** East Crawford Water Supply Corporation (East Crawford) and North Bosque Water Supply Corporation (North Bosque) (collectively, Applicants) and file this Request for Extension. The Applicants have conferred with the Public Utility Commission Staff (Staff) and Staff is unopposed to this Motion. The Applicants respectfully show the following:

### I. BACKGROUND

On October 7, 2020, Applicants filed an application for the approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of a portion of water facilities, along with portions of each Applicant's respective Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in McLennan County, Texas (Application). North Bosque holds CCN number 10023 and East Crawford holds CCN number 11396.

On December 22, 2020, Order No. 4 was issued, finding the Application incomplete and deficient, and establishing an opportunity for the Applicants to cure the items listed in the PUC Memorandum from Patricia Garcia by January 15, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

### **II. MOTION FOR EXTENSION**

In particular, the Memorandum from Patricia Garcia listed mapping deficiencies from both Applicants that have required a great deal of additional coordination and mapping edits by the two Applicants' engineers. The Applicants' engineers have worked closely and diligently to pursue the updated mapping, but there are many items to cure. Another deficiency involved the City of Waco (City) and the Applicants and the City would benefit from more time to discuss dual certification and/or decertification and come to an agreement. 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), provides that the time for filing documents may be extended upon a showing of good cause. Applicants are diligently working amongst themselves and with PUC's GIS department to correct the mapping deficiencies identified by the Memorandum from Patricia Garcia; however, the complexity of the overlap caused by two water supply systems' boundaries and the additional boundaries of a city is slowing the progress. Wherefore, the Applicants respectfully request that their deadline to cure the deficiencies be extended to February 15, 2021.

### II. CONCLUSION

Wherefore, East Crawford and North Bosque respectfully move that the Commission issue an order granting Applicants' request and extend the deadline for Applicants to cure to February 15, 2021.
