JOINT MOTION TO ADMIT SUPPLEMENTAL EVIDENCE

On October 9, 2020, Dos Aguas LLC (Dos Aguas) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Walker, San Jacinto, and Montgomery counties. The requested service area consists of approximately 5,387 acres to be developed into 292 one-acre lots in Walker County and 1,800 to 1,900 one and one-half to two acre-lots in Montgomery County.¹ On July 8, 2021, Dos Aguas and Commission Staff (collectively, the parties) filed a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed notice of approval. On July 29, August 18, and September 7, 2021, the parties filed supplemental information to clarify the record.

I. MOTION TO ADMIT SUPPLEMENTAL EVIDENCE

The parties move to admit the following supplemental evidence into the record of this proceeding:

1. Dos Aguas' response to Order No. 6 filed on July 29, 2021 (Interchange Item No. 32);
2. Dos Aguas' response to Staff's third request for information (RFI) filed on August 18, 2021 (Interchange Item No. 36); and
3. Commission Staff's response to Order No. 6, including all attachments, filed on September 7, 2021 (Interchange Item No. 37).

¹ The requested area is bounded on the east by Peach Creek, which is located on the border between—and therefore includes land from—Montgomery and San Jacinto Counties. Because the only portion of San Jacinto County included in the requested area is the Peach Creek waterway, this portion of the requested area will not be developed into lots.

II. CONCLUSION

The parties respectfully request that the items listed above be admitted as supplemental evidence into the record of this proceeding as evidence and that proposed notice of approval filed on July 8, 2021 be adopted.
