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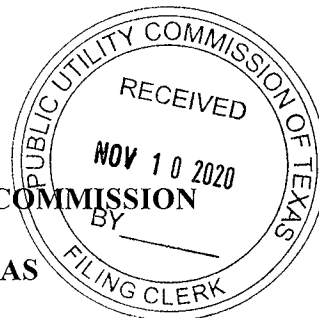

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of Dos Aguas, LLC, filed on October 9, 2020, to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Walker and Montgomery counties. On October 21 and 29, 2020, Dos Aguas filed supplements to the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By December 7, 2020, Dos Aguas must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Patricia Garcia's November 9, 2020 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By January 18, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
