RE: Docket No. 51407, *Application of Dos Aguas, LLC for a Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Walker and Montgomery Counties.*

At the October 6, 2022 open meeting, the Commission approved, in part, the revised proposed order in this docket. Dos Aguas demonstrated that it has the financial, technical, and managerial capability to provide service to an area that can be served by water plant one. Dos Aguas further demonstrated that water plant one has the capacity to serve 583 connections. The Commission determined that it will grant a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to Dos Aguas for a service area that includes 583 connections rather than the requested service area that includes 1,170 connections. Before the Commission issues its final order in this proceeding, a water CCN map and certificate that conform with the Commission's determinations must be prepared to attach to the final order.

Accordingly, Dos Aguas must file in this docket a map that shows a revised service area of 583 connections (for 583 contiguous lots), all applicable mapping information required by 16 TAC § 24.257, and any additional information requested by Commission Staff to prepare a water CCN map and certificate that conform with the Commission's decision.

Within 30 days of Dos Aguas' filing, Commission Staff must file a response to this memo to either: 1) confirm that Dos Aguas filed sufficient information for Commission Staff to prepare a water CCN map and certificate that conform with the Commission's decision; or 2) state that Dos Aguas did not provide sufficient information, and identify what mapping information is needed from Dos Aguas for Commission Staff to prepare a water CCN map and certificate that conform with the Commission's decision.

If Commission Staff files a response to this memo that confirms Dos Aguas filed sufficient information, Commission Staff must prepare and file a water CCN map and certificate that conform with the Commission's decision. This should be done as soon as practicable, but no later than 30 days from the date it files its response to this memo.
