JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE REGARDING RATE CASE EXPENSES

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO), Cities Advocating for Reasonable Deregulation (CARD), Office of Public Utility Counsel (OPUC), and Texas Industrial Energy Consumers (TIEC) (collectively, the Parties) and file this Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule Regarding Rate Case Expenses.¹ In support thereof, the Parties show the following:

I. JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On November 23, 2020, the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) filed SOAH Order No. 2 adopting a procedural schedule in this docket. The Parties seek to modify the procedural schedule in SOAH Order No. 2 to address rate case expenses. The Parties propose the following procedural schedule below:

Supplemental Direct Testimony on Rate Case Expenses	May 5, 2021
SWEPCO and CARD Supplemental Rebuttal Testimony on Rate Case Expenses	May 12, 2021
