Re: Notification of Name Change – CCN No. 20465

Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority to Gulf Coast Authority

Dear Filing Clerk:

Gulf Coast Authority hereby notifies the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUC") that on June 15, 2017, the 85th Legislature of Texas changed the name of Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority ("GCWDA") to Gulf Coast Authority ("GCA"). GCA respectfully requests that the PUC update its records to show GCA as the holder of CCN No. 20465.

GCA is a conservation and reclamation district created pursuant to Chapter 409, Acts of the 61st Legislature of Texas, Regular Session, 1969, as amended. Its name as stated in Chapter 409 was the GCWDA. Senate Bill No. 1489, which became effective on June 15, 2017, amended those sections of Chapter 409 that referenced GCWDA and changed those references to GCA. Senate Bill No. 1489 also added Section 2.015 to Chapter 409. Section 2.015 provides, "A reference in law to the Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority means Gulf Coast Authority." A copy of S.B. No. 1489 is attached.

Because the Texas Legislature changed the name of the CCN holder from GCWDA to GCA by statute, and the statute by which the change was made provides that a reference in law to GCWDA means GCA, GCA Is not aware of notice or other requirements that may apply to this name change request.

2 relating to the Gulf Coast Waste Disposal Authority.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 1.02, Chapter 409, Acts of the 61st

5 Legislature, Regular Session, 1969, is amended to read as follows:

6 Sec. 1.02. FINDINGS AND DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby

7 found and declared that the quality of waters in Chambers,

8 Galveston, and Harris Counties is materially affected by the

9 disposal of wastes throughout those counties; that regional

10 approaches to studying water pollution in these counties, to

11 planning corrective and preventive measures, to providing

12 coordinated facilities for waste disposal, and to regulating waste

13 disposal would be far more effective than efforts on a county-wide,

14 city-wide, or smaller scale; that solid wastes, as well as other

15 kinds of waste, may impair water quality by seepage, drainage, and

16 otherwise; that creation of the Gulf Coast [Waste Disposal]

17 Authority would advance the established policy of the state to

18 maintain the quality of the waters in the state consistent with the

19 public health and public enjoyment thereof, the propagation and

20 protection of terrestrial and aquatic life, the operation of

21 existing industries, and the economic development of the state; and

22 that impending shortage of water in the district for beneficial

23 uses requires that all reasonable measures be taken to prevent and

24 abate water pollution, and to reclaim polluted water for beneficial

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 1.03(a)(1), Chapter 409, Acts of the
- 3 61st Legislature, Regular Session, 1969, is amended to read as
- 4 follows:
- 5 (1) "Authority" means the Gulf Coast [Waste Disposal]
- 6 Authority created by this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 2.01, Chapter 409, Acts of the 61st
- 8 Legislature, Regular Session, 1969, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 Section 2.01. CREATION OF AUTHORITY. There is hereby
- 10 created, pursuant to Article XVI, Section 59, of the Texas
- 11 Constitution, a conservation and reclamation district to be known
- 12 as the Gulf Coast [Waste Disposal] Authority, which shall be a
- 13 governmental agency and body politic and corporate of the State of
- 14 Texas. A confirmation election shall not be necessary.
- 15 SECTION 4. Chapter 409, Acts of the 61st Legislature,
- 16 Regular Session, 1969, is amended by adding Section 2.015 to read as
- 17 follows:
- Sec. 2.015. NAME CHANGE. A reference in law to the Gulf
- 19 Coast Waste Disposal Authority means the Gulf Coast Authority.
- 20 SECTION 5. Section 8104.006, Special District Local Laws
- 21 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 8104.006. RELATIONSHIP TO GULF COAST [WASTE DISPOSAL]
- 23 AUTHORITY. The rights, powers, privileges, and functions granted
- 24 to the authority under this chapter are subject to the powers
- 25 granted to the Gulf Coast [Waste Disposal] Authority in Chapter
- 26 409, Acts of the 61st Legislature, Regular Session, 1969 (Article
- 27 7621d-2, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), to provide disposal

- 1 systems.
- 2 SECTION 6. Section 8104.205, Special District Local Laws
- 3 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 8104.205. CONSENT REQUIRED FOR WASTE TREATMENT AND
- 5 DISPOSAL FACILITIES. Before acquiring or constructing a waste
- 6 treatment or disposal facility, the authority must obtain the
- 7 consent of the:
- 8 (1) Gulf Coast [Waste Disposal] Authority; or
- 9 (2) Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, if the
- 10 consent of the Gulf Coast [Waste Disposal] Authority is
- 11 unreasonably withheld or delayed.
- 12 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
