**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION INSUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the October 22, 2020 application of the City of Brenham to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) and for partial dual certification with Central Washington County Water Supply Corporation’s water CCN in Washington County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By December 21, 2020, the City of Brenham must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Jolie Mathis’ November 23, 2020 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By January 25, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
