**COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE
COMPLETENESS AND PROPOSED NOTICE**

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Notice. Staff recommends that the application be deemed administratively complete. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On October 21, 2020, Aqua Texas, Inc. (Aqua Texas) and Aqua Utilities, Inc. (Aqua Utilities) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Bandera County. Specifically, Applicants seek to transfer the Blue Medina Water public water system from Aqua Utilities to Aqua Texas. The total requested area consists of 474 acres with 75 customer connections. Applicants filed supplemental information on November 10, 2020 and November 18, 2020.

On October 28, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 1, ordering Staff to file recommendation on the administrative completeness of the application, proposed notice and to file a recommendation regarding how to proceed with the application and to propose a procedural schedule by November 23, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS

Staff has reviewed the application and, as detailed in the attached memorandum from Patricia Garcia, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the application be found administratively complete. Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness is not a comment on the merits of the application, but only that it is complete for further processing.

III. NOTICE

At this time, Staff recommends that the Applicants proceed with providing public notice to all current customers, persons, political subdivisions, and other entities listed in the attached memorandum using the notice provided by Ms. Garcia. Along with each individual notice, Staff recommends that Applicants provide an accurate map delineating the requested service area. Within 30 days of the provision of notice, Staff recommends that the Applicants file proof of notice as described in the attached memorandum. Finally, Staff recommends that the Applicants use the attached notices and affidavits to meet these requirements.

IV. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff recommends the application be found administratively complete. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	December 27, 2020
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	January 11, 2021
Deadline to intervene	Thirty (30) days after notice is issued

V. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully recommends that the application be found administratively complete, that the Applicants be directed to provide notice as detailed in the attached memorandum, and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted.

Medina River Ranch and Blue Medina.

The requested area overlaps the district boundaries of the Bandera County River Authority. If Bandera County River Authority does not request a public hearing, the Commission shall determine that the district is consenting to the Aqua Texas, Inc.'s request to provide retail water utility service in the requested area.

The requested area is located approximately 7 mile(s) southeast of downtown Bandera, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Medina River; on the east by a line approximately 1 mile west of FM 1283; on the south by Medina River; and on the west by Medina River. The total requested area includes approximately 474 acres and 75 current customers.

See enclosed map showing the requested area.

This transaction will not have an effect on the current customer's rates and services.

You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the uncertificated requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area (“opt out”) within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All opt out requests must include a large-scale map, a metes and bounds description of the landowner’s tract of land, landowner’s name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable.
