**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, NOTICE
SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the November 2, 2020 petition and November 10, 2020 supplement to the petition, filed by Aqua Texas, Inc. and the City of Austin under Texas Water Code § 13.248 and to amend water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Travis County.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and the notice sufficient to satisfy the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.253(c).

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing:

Deadline to intervene	December 9, 2020
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to petitioners for review and consent	December 30, 2020
Deadline for petitioners to file signed consent forms with the Commission	January 13, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the petition	January 20, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	January 27, 2021
