FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the November 4, 2020 application of Chester Maples dba Old Highway 90 Water Service to amend its water certificates of convenience and necessity in Medina and Frio counties. On December 9 and 10, 2020 and January 19, March 16, and April 14, 2021, Old Highway 90 supplemented the application. On May 14, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs Old Highway 90 to provide notice of the application as described in the May 14, 2021 memorandum of Patricia Garcia attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms attached to Commission Staff's recommendation.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule	July 13, 2021
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
