**ORDER NO. 4
GRANTING UNOPPOSED EXTENSION AND REVISING DEADLINES**

This Order addresses the January 26, 2021 unopposed motion to extend the time for JLM 717 Kaufman LP to supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in Reginald Tuvilla's January 4, 2021 memorandum, which was attached to Commission Staff's recommendation of the same date.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants JLM 717 Kaufman's unopposed motion to for extension.

On or before February 2, 2021, JLM 717 Kaufman must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in Reginald Tuvilla's January 4, 2021 memorandum. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed.

In light of the extension above, the ALJ adjusts the deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition to February 18, 2021.
