**ORDER NO. 6  
FINDING PETITION REMAINS ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE  
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the petition filed by JLM 717 Kaufman LP on November 17, 2020, for expedited release from the City of Crandall's water certificate of convenience and necessity in Kaufman County. On February 3 and March 4 and 5, 2021, petitioner filed supplements to the petition.

The administrative law judge finds the application remains administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review.

On or before April 12, 2021, JLM 717 must supplement the petition to cure the deficiencies described in Reginald Tuvilla's March 11, 2021 memorandum, which was attached to Commission Staff's recommendation on the same date. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the petition cannot proceed.

On or before May 12, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
