**ORDER NO. 8  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND  
ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice filed by Franklin Water Service Co. LLC and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC. On May 20, 2021, CSWR-Texas filed the affidavit of Josiah Cox, president of CSWR-Texas, attesting that notice was mailed to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on May 20, 2021. CSWR-Texas also filed a copy of the notice and maps sent. On May 21, 2021, CSWR-Texas filed confidential exhibit B to the notice, which included a list of all recipients to whom notice was provided. On June 25, 2021, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule:

Notice completed	May 20, 2021
Deadline for intervention	June 21, 2021 <sup>1</sup>
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale and on the certificate of convenience and necessity amendment	July 22, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	August 5, 2021

<sup>1</sup> Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(b), the intervention period shall not be less than 30 days unless good cause is shown. Notice was mailed on May 20, 2021. Therefore, 30 days after May 20, 2021 is June 19, 2021. Because June 19, 2021, is a Saturday, the deadline for intervention is Monday, June 21, 2021 under 16 TAC § 22.4(a).

Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed	August 20, 2021
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	September 17, 2021 <sup>2</sup>
