JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF REHEARING

COME NOW, Rockett Special Utility District ("Rockett") and Compass Datacenters DFW III, LLC ("Compass") (collectively, the "Parties"), by and through their attorneys herein, and file this Joint Motion for Extension of Rehearing pursuant to PUC Rule 22.264 and Texas Government Code § 2001.146(e), requesting the Public Utility Commission of Texas (the "Commission") grant an extension related to the Motion for Rehearing in this proceeding. In support thereof, the Parties would respectfully show as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

On November 20, 2020, Compass filed a petition for streamlined expedited release, pursuant to Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h), from Rockett's water CCN No. 10099 (the "Petition"), where the properties subject to the Petition are Tract A being approximately 73 acres and Tract B being approximately 73 acres in Ellis County (collectively, the "Property").

On October 12, 2021, the Commission issued its Order releasing the Property from Rockett's service area under CCN No. 10099.¹

On November 5, 2021, Rockett filed its Motion for Rehearing.

On November 15, 2021, the Commission issued its notice to hear the Motion for Rehearing on December 2, 2021.²

On November 22, 2021, Compass filed it Response to Rockett's Motion for Rehearing.

II. JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND REHEARING

Order at 7, ¶ 1 (Oct. 12, 2021).

Notice, Item 41 at 1 (Nov. 15, 2021).

The Parties are currently engaged in settlement discussions and are working to resolve all issues in this proceeding, and would prefer to avoid unnecessary costs while the Parties work towards resolution.

Thus, in accordance with PUC Rule § 22.264(d), the Parties request that the Commission grant an extension of the rehearing from December 2, 2021 to January 13, 2022, as authorized by Tex. Gov't Code § 2001.146(e) and (i). The Commission typically has to act on a motion for rehearing within 55 days after the date of the Order, but this deadline to act can be extended up to 100 days by a party's motion.³ Here, the Parties jointly move for the hearing on December 2, 2021 be postponed to January 13, 2022 for good cause to allow the Parties to continue settlement efforts. The Parties anticipate this proposed extension will allow sufficient time to resolve matters regarding settlement.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Rockett and Compass respectfully request the extension for rehearing to January 13, 2022.
