**ORDER NO. 9**  
**FINDING NOTICE, AS SUPPLEMENTED, SUFFICIENT**  
**AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Monarch Utilities I L.P. regarding its application to amend sewer certificate of convenience and necessity number 20899 in Chambers County. On June 14, 2021, Monarch filed affidavits attesting to direct and published notice. Monarch’s mailing list indicated that it did not need to provide notice to Chambers County Municipal Utility Districts 2 and 3 because they were no longer active and that there were “No GCDs.”<sup>1</sup> On July 16, 2021, Monarch supplemented its proof of notice clarifying that Chambers County Municipal Utility Districts 2 and 3 are dormant. Additionally, Monarch clarified that “GCDs” refers to groundwater conservation districts and included documentation demonstrating that there are no active groundwater conservation districts in Chambers County.

On July 30, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding Monarch’s notice, as supplemented, and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge finds Monarch’s notice, as supplemented, sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:



Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificate, and tariffs (if applicable) to Monarch for review and consent	September 13, 2021
Deadline for Monarch to file its consent form with the Commission	September 27, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a final recommendation on the application	October 11, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	October 25, 2021
