**COMMISSION STAFF’S SECOND MOTION FOR AN AMENDED PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE**

On December 3, 2020, Monarch Utilities I L.P. (Monarch) filed an application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) 20899 in Chambers County, Texas. Monarch's application indicates that there are no customers in the areas proposed for decertification. Monarch filed supplemental information on February 17, 2021, April 29, 2021, June 14, 2021, September 24, 2021, and November 19, 2021.

On March 4, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 14, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application by March 24, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME & MOTION FOR AMENDED
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Commission Staff continues to work with Monarch to resolve the tariff dispute. Staff therefore requests that the remaining deadlines in the procedural schedule be adjusted accordingly. As such, Staff proposes to amend the procedural schedule as follows:

Event	Date
Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificate, and tariffs (if applicable) to Applicants for review and consent	April 25, 2022
Deadline for Applicant to file consent forms with the Commission	May 9, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	May 23, 2022
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	June 6, 2022

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order amending the procedural schedule.
