ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO WITHDRAW OR CURE

This Order addresses administrative completeness of the application, filed on December 10, 2020, for a Class D annual rate adjustment for certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 13282. The application purports to be filed for a utility with the name "Cedar Creek Water Supply" by an applicant with the name "Estes Water Supply LLC." However, the holder of CCN number 13282 is "Megan Estes dba Cedar Creek Water Supply" and "Megan Estes dba Big Creek West Water Supply."

On January 11, 20201, Commission Staff filed a recommendation that the application be found deficient because Estes Water Supply LLC has no authority to file an application for CCN number 13282.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and deficient. By February 11, 2021, the applicant must file a request to withdraw the application, or the actual owner of CCN number 13282 may join the application and supplement it to cure the deficiencies. By March 15, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
