ORDER NO. 3 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Markout Water Supply Corporation and the City of Mesquite regarding the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Kaufman County. On January 29, 2021, Mesquite filed affidavits attesting to the provision of notice of the application to the affected parties on January 27, 2021. Representative copies of the notice and map were attached to the affidavits.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule applies for continued processing:

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on the approval of the sale	March 26, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation	April 26, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	May 5, 2021
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	May 27, 2021 ¹

¹ Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.239(a) and (j), the deadline for Commission action is one hundred twenty (120) days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. One hundred and twenty days after January 27, 2021 is Wednesday, May 27, 2021.
