**CORRECTED ORDER NO. 7  
FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION INSUFFICIENT AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of Markout Water Supply Corporation and the City of Mesquite for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Kaufman County. The applicants filed closing documentation on August 20, 2021.

On September 15, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of the closing documents.


The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation insufficient. Specifically, the application and supporting documents indicate that Markout WSC intends to dissolve as an entity. While the applicants represent that there are no outstanding customer deposits associated with the public water system being transferred, the applicants did not address whether the membership shares of the members of Markout WSC would be refunded nor did the applicants provide a list showing the amount of the membership fee and interest to be refunded.
