Re: Request for Registration of Water billing (Allocation) for Arielle Springwoods located at 21145 Spring Plaza Drive, Spring, Texas 77388

Dear Commissioner PUC,

Adara Communities from Houston, TX recently acquired the property, Arielle Springwoods (formerly known as Cortland Spring Plaza). We are requesting the PUC registration to change the tenant billing from submetered to an allocated method due to the calculation of the water base fee from the Spring West MUD, resulting in tenant water bills that never fluctuate with their actual submetered usage.

Spring West MUD includes 5,000 gallons of water per apartment unit in the water base fee. The base water rate is currently calculated at \$20 per unit and the sewer charges are assessed as a base only at \$27.50 per unit. While the community has 340 units, the provider is charging for 342 units to include other clubhouse facilities with toilets. The rate structure for Spring West MUD does not include a consumption charge for sewer.

Because 5,000 gallons of water per dwelling unit is included in the base charge, the community will not be billed for metered consumption until the property collectively exceeds the usage covered by the base, 1,710,000 gallons (342 units*5,000 gallons). Based on historical consumption, is it highly unlikely the community would ever exceed that minimum. The total gallons used at the community for the last 3 months were as follows: 1,512,000 (10/30/2020-12/2/2020); 1,286,000 (10/2/2020-10/30/2020); and 1,377,000 (9/3/2020-10/2/2020). The 6-month average at the community has been 1,361,500 gallons. The community has averaged 94% occupancy during these time periods, so it is stable and never expected to exceed the 1,710,000 base gallons to start getting billed for consumption.

Due to this water rate structure billed to the community by Spring West MUD, we feel it is deceiving to the residents of Arielle Springwoods to bill individual submetered usage as the residents' bills will never fluctuate with their own individual consumption. Thus, Adara Communities is requesting a change from the submetered water billing and moving over to an allocated method. This will result in similar, consistent water bills for our residents, yet much easier to explain to residents when inquiring how their monthly water bill is calculated.

Arielle Springwoods will allocate the monthly water/wastewater bill(s) for the community based on the allocation method using the 50/50 occupancy/SF method (method iv, combination of actual and sf) and the occupancy will be calculated based on the Estimated Occupancy method (iii).
