METHOD USED TO ALLOCATE UTILITY CHARGES Check the box or boxes that describe the allocation method used to bill tenants. Occupancy method: The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by the total number of occupants in all dwelling units at the beginning of the month for which bills are being rendered. Ratio occupancy method: Number of Occupants for **Number of Occupants Billing Purposes** The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit 1.0 1 is adjusted as shown in the table to the right. Estimated occupancy method: Number of Number of Occupants for **Bedrooms Billing Purposes** 0 (Efficiency) The estimated occupancy for each unit is based on the number of bedrooms as shown in the table to the 1.6 right. The estimated occupancy in the tenant's 2 2.8 dwelling unit is divided by the total estimated 3 4.0 occupancy in all dwelling units regardless of the actual 4.0 + 1.2 for each additional bedroom >3 number of occupants or occupied units. Occupancy and size of rental unit percent (in which no more than 50%) of the utility bill for water/wastewater consumption is allocated using the occupancy method checked above. The remainder is allocated according to either: • the size of the tenant's dwelling unit divided by the total size of all dwelling units, OR • the size of the space rented by the tenant of a manufactured home divided by the size of all rental spaces. Submetered hot water: The individually submetered hot water used in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by all submetered hot water used in all dwelling units. Submetered cold water is used to allocate charges for hot water provided through a central system: The individually submetered cold water used in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by all submetered cold water used in all dwelling units.
