METHOD USED TO ALLOCATE UTILITY CHARGES Check the box or boxes that describe the allocation method used to bill tenants. Occupancy method: The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit is divided by the total number of occupants in all dwelling units at the beginning of the month for which bills are being rendered. Ratio occupancy method: Number of Occupants for Number of Occupants Billing Purposes The number of occupants in the tenant's dwelling unit 1.0 is adjusted as shown in the table to the right.
