**GRANTING MOTION TO COMPEL AND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION; AND
ESTABLISHING DEADLINES TO RESPOND TO REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION
AND TO FILE A SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT OF POSITION**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 23, 2021 motion to compel and request for extension. Commission Staff requests that the Gallery Apartments be directed to respond to its requests for information (RFIs) and that Commission Staff's deadline to file a supplemental statement of position be extended. Commission Staff contends, to date, that the Gallery Apartments has not responded to its RFIs, its attempts to contact the Gallery Apartments has been unsuccessful, and the Gallery Apartments has not contacted Commission Staff to seek more time to respond to its RFIs. Commission Staff states that its RFIs to the Gallery Apartments is material to the complaint and needed for Commission Staff to formulate a position.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants Commission Staff's motion to compel. By August 20, 2021, the Gallery Apartments must file a response to Commission Staff's RFIs in accordance with 16 TAC § 22.144(c)(1).

The ALJ grants Commission Staff's request for extension. By August 20, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental statement of position regarding this complaint and address whether a default order would be appropriate in this docket.
