WATERS OF VISTA RANCH WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION AND AQUA WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION'S SECOND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

Waters of Vista Ranch Supply Corporation (WOVR WSC) and Aqua Water Supply Corporation (AWSC) (collectively, Applicants) file this Second Request for Extension of Time to File Supplement to Application and Supplemental Recommendation with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), pursuant to Order No. 2 dated January 22, 2021, and Order No. 3 dated February 23, 2021. In support, Applicants would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On December 21, 2020, Applicants filed an application for approval of the sale and transfer of certificate of convenience and necessity rights in Fayette County. On January 21, 2021, Commission Staff recommended that the application be found administratively incomplete. On January 22, 2021, in Order No. 2, the Administrative Law Judge established February 22, 2021 as the deadline by which Applicants must file a supplemental application to cure the deficiencies described in Staff's recommendation. Order No. 2 further established March 24, 2021 as the deadline by which Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the

administrative completeness of the application, with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate. On February 22, 2021, Applicants filed their Request for Extension of Time to file a supplemental application to cure the deficiencies described in Staff's recommendation. On February 23, 2021, in Order No. 3, the Administrative Law Judge granted the Applicants Request for Extension of Time and established March 2, 2021 as the new deadline by which Applicants must file a supplemental application to cure deficiencies described in Staff's recommendation. Order No. 3 further established April 1, 2021 as the deadline by which Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Applicants request to extend the deadline to file the supplement to application and the supplemental recommendation described in Order No. 2 and Order No. 3 to March 10, 2021, and April 8, 2021, respectively. Due to the current natural disaster declaration, the parties need additional time to address the deficiencies outlined in Commission Staff's recommendation. This request is not intended for the purpose of unnecessary delay, and has not been caused by neglect, indifference, or lack of diligence.

III. CONCLUSION

Applicants respectfully request the issuance of an order granting Applicants' request and extending the deadline to file a supplement to the application to March 10, 2021, and the deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation and proposed procedural schedule to April 8, 2021.
