ORDER NO. 7 FINDING APPLICATION REMAINS INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the December 21, 2020 application of Waters of Vista Ranch Water Supply Corporation and Aqua Water Supply Corporation for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Fayette County. On March 10, 2021, Waters of Vista Ranch and Aqua Water filed a supplement to the application.

The administrative law judge finds the application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before May 8, 2021, Waters of Vista Ranch and Aqua Water must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the April 8, 2021 memorandum of Jolie Mathis. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Waters of Vista Ranch and Aqua Water must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

On or before June 7, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
