**WATERS OF VISTA RANCH WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION AND AQUA WATER  
SUPPLY CORPORATION'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE  
SECOND SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION**

Waters of Vista Ranch Water Supply Corporation (WOVR WSC) and Aqua Water Supply Corporation (AWSC) (collectively, Applicants) file this Request for Extension of Time to File Second Supplement to Application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), pursuant to Order No. 7 dated April 12, 2021.<sup>1</sup> In support, Applicants would show the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On December 21, 2020, Applicants filed an application for approval of the sale and transfer of certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights in Fayette County. Aqua WSC seeks approval to acquire all facilities and CCN rights under WOVR WSC's CCN number 12927, and to amend Aqua WSC's CCN number 10294 to include additional uncertified area. On January 21, 2021, Commission Staff recommended that the application be found administratively incomplete. On March 4, 2021, in Order No. 5, the Honorable Administrative Law Judge established a revised deadline of March 10, 2021, as the deadline by which Applicants must file a supplemental application to cure the deficiencies described in Staff's recommendation. On March 10, 2021, Applicants filed their Response and Application Supplement to cure the deficiencies described in

Staff's recommendation. On April 8, 2021, Commission Staff filed their Supplemental Recommendation on Administrative Completeness and Proposed Notice, and again recommended that the application be found administratively incomplete. On April 12, 2021, in Order No. 7, the Honorable Administrative Law Judge established May 8, 2021 as the deadline by which Applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in Staff's April 8, 2021 recommendation. Order No. 7 further established June 7, 2021 as the deadline by which Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

## **II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Applicants request to extend the deadline to file the supplement to application and the supplemental recommendation described in Order No. 7 to May 19, 2021, and June 18, 2021, respectively. Applicants are coordinating with Commission Staff and working to develop revised mapping documents, and need additional time to finalize them. This request is not intended for the purpose of unnecessary delay, and has not been caused by neglect, indifference, or lack of diligence.

## **III. CONCLUSION**

Applicants respectfully request the issuance of an order granting Applicants' request and extending the deadline to file a second supplement to the application to May 19, 2021, and the deadline for Commission Staff to file a supplemental recommendation and proposed procedural schedule to June 18, 2021.
