ORDER NO. 12
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Waters of Vista Ranch Water Supply Corporation and Aqua Water Supply Corporation regarding the application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Fayette County. On July 26, 2021, applicants filed: (1) the affidavit of Dave McMurry, general manager of Aqua WSC, attesting that individual notice was mailed to all required parties on July 19 and 22, 2021; and (2) a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice in *The Fayette County Record*, a newspaper of general circulation in Fayette County, on July 13 and July 20, 2021.

On August 25, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding applicants' notice and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.


The administrative law judge finds applicants' notice sufficient and adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

The following procedural schedule applies:

Notice completed	July 22, 2021
Deadline to intervene	August 21, 2021
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and on the CCN amendment	October 8, 2021
Deadline for applicants to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	October 22, 2021
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed	November 5, 2021
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	November 19, 2021
