**ORDER NO. 5
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by the City of Anna. On June 24, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the notice provided.

On June 4, 2021, City of Anna filed the affidavit of Todd Strouse, a representative of City of Anna, attesting that notice of the application was mailed to the affected parties on May 12, 2021. Included in the filing, was the affidavit of Jeanine Sewell, legal clerk of the *Anna-Melissa Tribune*, which is a newspaper of general circulation in Collin County, indicating that notice of the application was published on May 13, and 20, 2021. Further, City of Anna on June 22, 2021, filed the affidavit of Todd Strouse, a representative of City of Anna, attesting that notice of the application was mailed to Greater Texoma Utility Authority on June 21, 2021.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Anna for review and consent	August 20, 2021
Deadline for Anna to file signed consent forms with the Commission	September 3, 2021
Deadline for Staff to request a hearing, or if no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	September 14, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	September 24, 2021
