This letter serves to transmit the response to the items requested for the pre-technical review of the Application for Permit No. WQ0016043001 – Hurricane creek Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The Domestic Technical Report 1.0, Section 1 states that the proposed design flows in the three phases will be 4, 8 and 16 MGD. Please provided documentation for how you arrived at those design flows such as number of connections projected etc.

- a) How many connections are being considered for this entire development and how much flow per connection was considered?
  - There will be an estimated 55,200-58,200 total connections for the entire service area
    with an estimated average flow of 275-290 gallons per day per connection. The
    connections included in the estimate are a mixture of existing and planned future
    developments. The attached maps show future planned land use maps and
    developments for the City of Anna.
- b) What is the proposed construction schedule for this development (i.e. # of homes constructed per month) and will it be fully constructed within the permit cycle or at least 10 years from the date of permit issuance?
  - The developments in the service area from the date of permit issuance has an estimated building at rate of 153-162 units per month an estimated 18,400-19,400 connections in the first 10 years. An approximately 57,000 single family units for the entire development over a span of 30 years.

- c) What is the population growth of the area, will it be enough to match the proposed development in a 10 year span or less?
  - The city of Anna has had a population increase of 82% from 2010 to 2019. The nearby City of Melissa has seen a population growth of 154%, and Collin County as a whole has expanded 32% since 2010.




