



ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES AND OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the application of the City of Anna to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Collin County.

The administrative law judge finds the application is administratively incomplete and insufficient for further review in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.8(b).

Under 16 TAC § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it finds the application administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By February 26, 2020, the City of Anna must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described in the January 27, 2021 memorandums of Alicia Maloy. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By March 29, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
