**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Pampa Investment Group, LP. On May 18, 2021, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the notice provided.

On April 14, 2021, Pampa filed the affidavit of Bret W. Fenner, a representative of Pampa, attesting that notice of the application was mailed to the affected parties on March 24, 2021. Included in the filing, was the affidavit of Jane Moon, classified manager of the *Temple Daily Telegram*, which is a newspaper of general circulation in Bell County, indicating that notice of the application was published on April 2, and 9, 2021.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Pampa for review and consent	June 16, 2021
Deadline for Pampa to file its signed consent form with the Commission	June 30, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	July 14, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	July 28, 2021
